

2011 PINELAND HOLSTEIN FUTURITY

Nomination Form

Now is the time to send in your entries for the 2011 Pineland Holstein Futurity, held in conjunction with the 2011 Northeast Fall National Show. Entries for the 2011 Futurity will be accepted immediately, with a one-time entry fee that stays with the animal, regardless of ownership.

The Futurity is open to any and all nominees, with no limitations on the numbers of nominees from any exhibitor. Plan on being a part of history as we showcase the finest Two Year-Olds in the Northeast with minimum prize monies to \$500 for our winner.

PROCEDURE: Complete owner information and entry blank on the reverse. Mail entry and check payable to New England States Holstein Association by **February 1, 2010**.

RULES AND AWARDS

ELIGIBILITY for 2011 Pineland Futurity:

Any Registered Holstein female (87%RHA or higher) that was born between Sept. 1, 2008 and Aug. 31, 2009 is eligible for the 2011 Pineland Holstein Futurity.

FEES:

One-time Nomination Fee of \$35.00 postmarked by February 1, 2010.

Nominations will be accepted February 2 to March 1 at \$75 per entry.

SHOWING:

In order to be eligible for any part of the purse, fees must have been made by the required date and the animal must be exhibited in a special 2 Year-Old Futurity Class held in conjunction with the Northeast Fall National Show in Springfield, MA. Animals must also be entered in their respective classes of the Northeast Fall National Show.

PURSE:

The purse in this 2011 Two Year-Old Futurity Class shall consist of the generous Pineland sponsorship as well all monies received by the New England States Holstein Association as Nomination Fees less any incidental expenses incurred for its promotion and management. The **minimum payout** shall be as follows:

1st Place.....	\$500
2nd Place.....	\$250
3rd Place	\$200
4th through 10th Place.....	\$150
11th through 20th Place.....	\$100

NO REFUNDS:

All nomination fees are committed to the purse and no refunds will be made unless for some reason the Futurity Show is cancelled.

TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF ELIGIBLE ANIMALS:

Any animal sold after being nominated initially will remain eligible provided the subsequent fees are paid as specified. In all cases, the responsibility of making required payments is the responsibility of the owner.

GENERAL:

The New England States Holstein Association, through its elected officers, is sponsoring and governing the Futurity, and will make all decisions not covered by these rules. However, they will not be responsible for accident or injury to animal or person in connection with the show.
