

2017 NORTHEAST YOUTH SHOW CALF SUMMIT

Friday & Saturday April 28 & 29th at the Rutland Fairgrounds, Rutland, VT

The 2017 Northeast Youth Show Calf Summit this year will be held at the Rutland Fairgrounds in Rutland, VT with registration, lunch & orientation from 11:30 to 12:45 on Friday. The formal program will then start at 12:45 and conclude with lunch on Saturday. Your registration fee of \$40 will cover your meals, tee shirt and some supplies. Enclosed is a separate registration form with the agreement for attendees and picture permission on the back. Both of these documents must be completely filled out and returned with your registration and registration fee. Checks to be made out to Vermont Holstein Association.

Rooms have been set aside at the Comfort Inn, Days Inn, Quality Inn and Hampton Inn in Rutland. All are very close to the fairgrounds. Each serves a plentiful breakfast and has a pool. The Comfort Inn rate is \$85.00. The Days Inn rates are one bed \$77.00 and two beds \$85.00 and the Quality Inn is \$60.00 for two beds and \$55.00 for one bed. The Hampton Inn rate is \$139.00 for two beds. These rates do not include the tax which must be added. **All require reservations by March 27th**. Please mention **Vermont Holstein Show Summit** to receive these special rates.

Directions:

Comfort Inn Rt. #7 (802-775-2200) is almost across from the fairground's main entrance. Take the road (Allen St.) by McDonalds with signs to the hospital. The Comfort Inn will be on your left.

Quality Inn Rt. #7 (802-773-3361) south of the fairgrounds on the west side of the road next to Aldis and Panera Restaurant. Going south it will be on your right.

Days Inn Rt. #7 (802-775-4303) south of the city. Go by the fairgrounds. It is opposite the Green Mtn. Plaza, Holiday Inn, Hampton Inn & next door to the Denny's Restaurant. Going south it will be on your left.

The Hampton Inn is across the road from Days Inn.

Fairgrounds on Rt.#7 south of the city. Entrance will be the livestock gate which is off Rt. #7. Take Dana Ave. just south of the fairgrounds to the livestock gate.
