Facilities will be available for move in or set up on Sunday July 15th after 9:00AM, and animals must be in by noon on Tuesday July 17th. Animals will be released after the show on Wednesday and need to be off the grounds that night. The facilities include multiple barns, an enclosed show arena, and a milking parlor.

Camper spaces that include water and electricity are available for \$75.00 for up to 3 nights

There will be an exhibitors meeting – time and location will be announced

Health certificates and registration papers must be available to be checked. NH health requirements are online at agriculture.nh.gov or 603-271-3551. No animals with evidence of contagious diseases will be allowed. Production information will need to be verified for 125,000 lb. class – please have DHI official info with you.

Initial sawdust ONLY will be provided. There are local farm supply stores that shavings and/or straw, as well as feed can be purchased from if you need a local source. The Barn Store 603-648-2888 located about 20 minutes from the fairgrounds, and Henniker Farm and Country Store 603-428-3255 located about 15 minutes from the fairgrounds

There is a milking parlor available for exhibitor use, or you may bring your own portable pump. ALL MILK MUST BE PUT IN THE TANK FOR DISPOSAL

Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor – Awards are based on 6 or less animals that accumulate the highest number of points. If a tie occurs, points will be calculated on the next highest placing animal. Partnership animals must have one partner designated to receive points when papers are checked. Farm units/Junior Exhibitors are considered one for Premier awards.

Adults and Juniors will be judged together with Juniors being recognized with Junior awards.

Granite State Dairy Promotion will provide coffee and donuts for exhibitors on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. A food vendor will be on the grounds Tuesday and Wednesday.

There will be a “pee-wee” showmanship class at noon on Wednesday during the lunch break. This class is open to ALL youth under the age of 8 and we encourage participation! Calves for this class may arrive Wednesday morning and prizes will be awarded to all participants.

Milking cow classes will begin at 1:00PM

Upon leaving, exhibitors will be required to clean out all loose feed and bedding from their stalls and put it on the manure pads.

If you are planning on bedding with straw – please indicate so on your entry We need to know for stalling assignments.
