Entry fee: \$ 20.00 per animal - Open exhibitors \$10.00 per animal - Junior Exhibitors

Late entries will be accepted at \$50.00 per animal after the deadline, dependent on space available. **ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON A FIRST RECEIVED BASIS WITH PAYMENT INCLUDED**

Entry fees based on number of animals entered, not number brought to the show.
Payment for entries and campers must be received with your entries.

Facilities will be available on Sunday, July 11 at 8:00AM. Animals will be released at the conclusion of the show and need to be off the grounds by midnight Wednesday. The facilities include multiple barns, an enclosed show arena, exhibitor showers, a milking parlor, and food service on the grounds beginning Tuesday.

Camper spaces that include water and electricity are available for \$35.00 for each night that they are hooked up and/or inhabited. Tent sites will be \$15.00

There will be an exhibitors meeting – time and location will be announced. Granite State Dairy Promotion will sponsor early morning coffee and donuts for exhibitors on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings.

The New England Holstein Summer Show will follow and comply with The Purebred Dairy Cattle Association Show Ring Code of Ethics

Health certificates and registration papers must be available to be checked. NH health requirements are online at agriculture.nh.gov or 603-271-3551. No animals with evidence of contagious diseases will be allowed. Production information will need to be verified for 125,000 lb. class – please have DHI official info with you.

Initial sawdust ONLY will be provided. If you need a local source for shavings or feed, we suggest you contact The Barn Store at 603-648-2888 (ask for Katie), located about 20 minutes from the fairgrounds. Delivery may be arranged.

Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor – Awards are based on 6 or less animals that accumulate the highest number of points. If a tie occurs, points will be calculated on the next highest placing animal. Partnership animals must have one partner designated to receive points when papers are checked. Farm units/Junior Exhibitors are considered one for Premier awards.

Adults and Juniors will be judged together with Juniors being recognized with Junior awards.

There will be a “pee-wee” showmanship class for youth under 9 on Wednesday during the lunch break.

*Milking cow classes will begin at 1:00PM

Grand Champion, Champion Bred and Owned, Premier Breeder, and Premier Exhibitor will be recognized with Championship banners.
