**Entry fees are based on the number of animals entered, not number brought to the show. Payment for Entries and Campers must be paid with your entries unless other arrangements are made.**

Facilities will be available Wednesday July 19, at 8 AM for cattle to arrive. Campers and Tack may be brought in prior the day before, if you want to bring them in sooner, please reach out to Dan LaCoss to make arrangements so the gate can be open at the fairgrounds. The facilities include multiple barns, an enclosed show arena, milking parlor, exhibitor showers and bathroom and food service will be available on Saturday July 22. There are multiple options for food close to the fairgrounds.

Camping spaces are available for \$35 for each night they are hooked up and or inhabited. Please sign up for camper space and payment when you do your online entries.

There will be an exhibitors meeting – time and location will be announced.

The New England Holstein Summer Show will follow and comply with The Purebred Dairy Cattle Association Show Ring Code of Ethics.
